A HIGH PSI service technician will service your machine _____ times per year at regularly scheduled intervals for \$90 per visit, (regularly \$125.00). Service will be provided when we are in your area, not on demand. The first half hour is included any additional labor will be billed at a reduced rate of \$80.00 per hour. You will also receive a 10% discount on parts used or purchased at time of service. Any additional maintenance required will only be performed after authorization. If we don't have the parts for the repair their will be no return trip charge. The preventive maintenance program requires a minimum of two service calls per year, and is subject to annual review and renewal. This program can be terminated by either party with a one week notice.
